12 & 13	Notoptera	Heelwalkers, Ice or rock crawlers	
5	Odonata	Damselflies and dragonflies	Record eye color before killing!! Kill in acetone. Store in glassine envelopes
10	Othoptera	Grasshoppers, locusts, katydids, crickets	Adult: pin; Nymph: ETOH
11	Phasmatodea	Walking sticks	Pin with cardboard support
18	Phthiraptera	Chewing & sucking lice	ETOH, slide mount
6	Plecoptera	Stoneflies	ETOH
17	Psocoptera	Bark and Book Lice	pin/point will shrivel & need to be rehydrated to study; ETOH and colors fade
21	Raphidioptera	Snakeflies	Pin/point; ETOH; envelopes
26	Siphonaptera	Fleas	70% ETOH
23	Strepsiptera	Strepsipterans	ETOH, slide mount
19	Thysanoptera	Thrips	ETOH, slide mount
27	Trichoptera		ETOH
9	Zoraptera	Angel insects	ETOH, slide mount
3	Zygentoma (Thysanura)	Silverfish	ETOH
